

## 1. Community Police

Please find below the policing report ranging from March 14<sup>th</sup> - April 14<sup>th</sup> 2024

- We have had one report for your area in regard to RTC's.
- We have had an increase in non-dwelling and dwelling burglaries in the Wiltshire area, there has been zero reports for your area at this time.
- We have received multiple reports of Pouching on farmland around the Hindon area, these are currently being looked into by the Rural crime team and they are making enquiries of known suspects.
- You have a very low level of antisocial behaviour occurring within your area which is good news.
- Lastly there have been a couple of Domestic related incidents reported to Wiltshire police but there are no patterns or themes around these incidents.
- We have been made aware of local concerns around vehicles Parking in a dangerous manner PCSO HUNT is currently looking into this and liaising with Partner agencies on best plans to resolve this.

Furthermore, the local neighbourhood team will be increasing presence in the rural community which will involve a higher presence of patrols in the area, this gives local communities the opportunity to engage with the officers and express any concerns they may have and also to gain any advice they may require.

I end on speaking about the Bobby Van that Wiltshire police offer which is a free service.
